## **Regulatory Standards**

- Currently no required Maximum Contaminant Level (MCM)
- Secondary Maximum Contaminant Level (SMCL) is > 0.05 mg/L
  - Levels above SMCLs can lead to loss of customer confidence in water quality / health
  - Compliance with SMCL is strongly encouraged by MassDEP
- MassDEP Health Advisory Level (HAL) is > 0.3 mg/L
  - > Recommends limited consumption >1 mg/L to decrease possible adverse neurological effects
  - Infants should not be given water with manganese > 0.3 mg/L for more than 10 days per year

## **Human Health Impacts**

Manganese is an essential nutrient in our diets

Over exposure can cause neurological impacts

Infants and children less than a year old are most susceptible

Can lead to learning disabilities

## **Other Impacts**

- Aesthetic issues for customers
  - Stain laundry and water use fixtures
  - Metallic or vinyl type water taste
  - Clog household water filters
  - Cause objectionable water color
  - Customer complaints
- Nuisance issues in distribution system
  - Pipe and other blockages from precipitate
  - May increase the number of coliform "hits"
