Water Rates and Fees Discussion – Public Hearing Continued

The Water Commission opened the continued Public Hearing on Water Rates and Fees. There was a continued discussion surrounding the Tiers. The Business Manager attempted to provide an explanation as to the Tier breakdown and the revisions. Commissioner Fishbone still has question concerning the Tiers. Tier #2 is higher than Tier #1 and it should be lower. So, there remains a disconnect between tier 1 and tier 2 water usage. The Commission has asked the Water Superintendent and the Office Assistant to try and reach back out to the Business Manager on the matter and try and get some explanation. The Office Assistant thought it would be a good suggestion to reach out to Northern Data, the Billing Software Vendor for an explanation.
